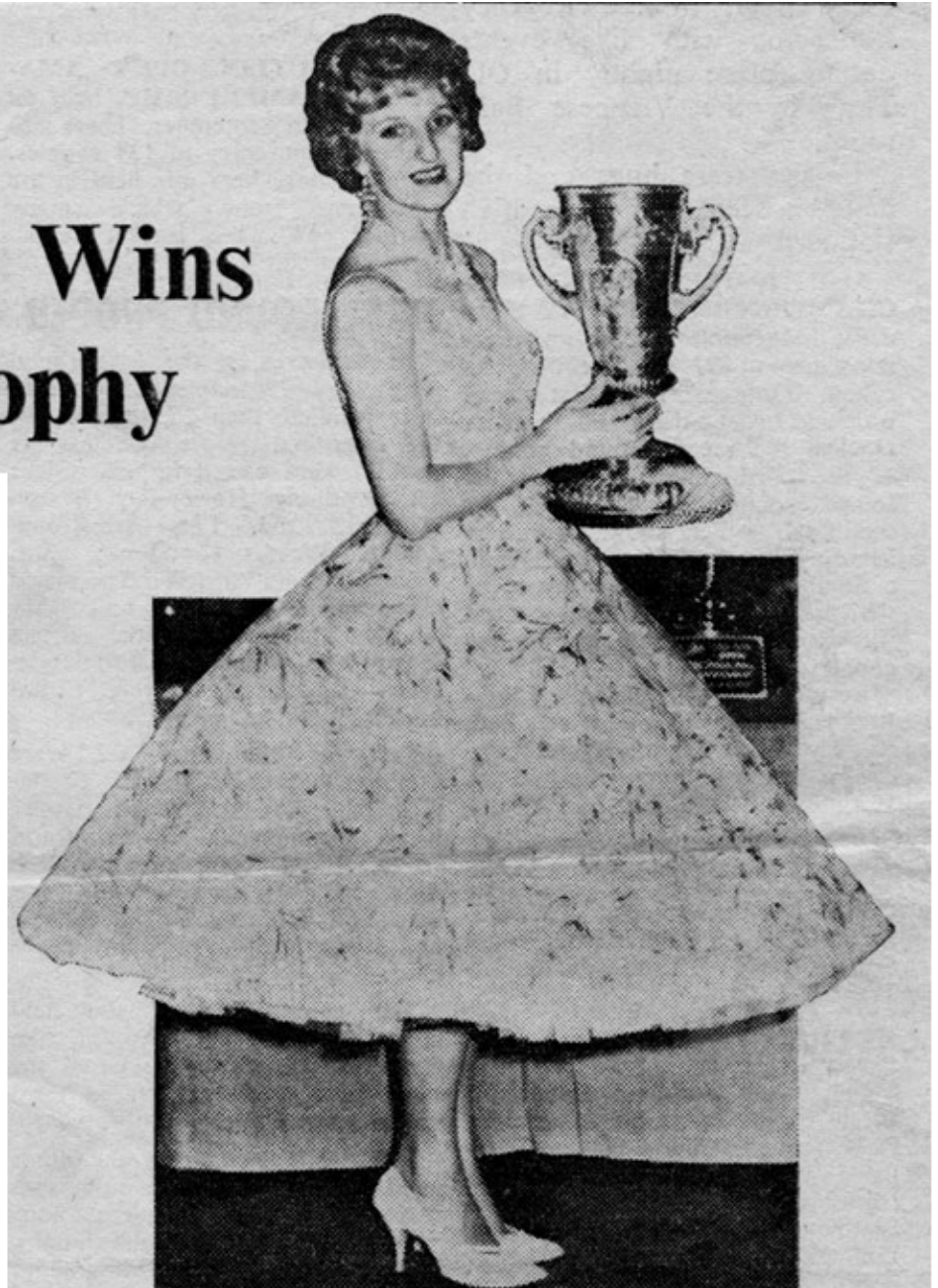


# The Pover Wins O.B. Trophy
